- About Allah Ta'ala granting the gift of five daily Salah.

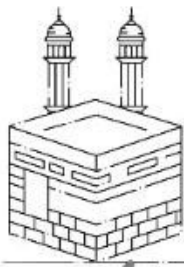
In today's activity we will be learning and making a folding picture book about Israa' & Mi'raj

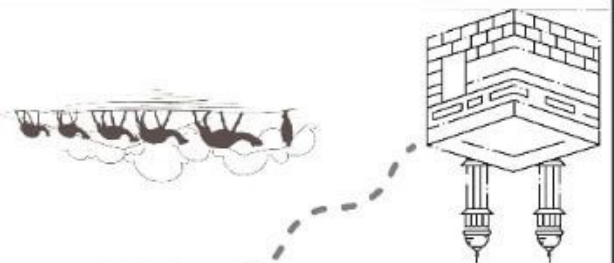

Introduction

Our beloved Nabi ﷺ was having a very difficult time. The Muslims were suffering in Makkah at the hands of the disbelievers. The journey to Ta'if had not been as successful as our beloved Nabi ﷺ had hoped and he had lost his beloved wife Sayyidah Khadeejah radhiyallahu anha and his uncle Abu Talib. Allah Ta'ala wanted to comfort our beloved Nabi and so gave him the opportunity of ﷺ meeting Him through Israa' and Mi'raj.

From Makkah to Jerusalem

Our beloved Nabi ﷺ's heart was washed with Zamzam and filled with Wisdom and Iman.

Our beloved Nabi ﷺ was taken by Sayyiduna Jibreel alayhis salam on the Buraq. The Buraq was an animal from Jannah; larger than a donkey but smaller than a mule. It was white and its stride was as long as the eye could see! Within moments they had left Makkah and were in Jerusalem.

From Baitul Maqdis to the 7 Heavens

Upon reaching Baitul Maqdis, they tied the Buraq to one of the walls of the Masjid and here our beloved Nabi ﷺ was honoured to lead 124,000 Prophets (alayhimus salam) in Salah!

They then went up to the 7 heavens. On each heaven meeting a Prophet.

Heaven 1: Nabi Adam alayhis salam

Heaven 2: Nabi Eesa & Nabi Yahya alayhimus salam

Heaven 3: Nabi Yusuf alayhis salam

Heaven 4: Nabi Idrees alayhis salam

Heaven 5: Nabi Haroon alayhis salam

Heaven 6: Nabi Moosa alayhis salam

Heaven 7: Nabi Ibraheem alayhis salam

Meeting Allah Ta'ala and the Gift of Salah

On reaching the Sidratul Muntaha, Sayyiduna Jibreel alayhis salam could go no further, so our beloved Nabi ﷺ continued alone. Our beloved Nabi ﷺ was taken to see Jannah and Jahannam. Our beloved Nabi ﷺ fell into Sajdah in front of Allah Ta'ala. It was here that he was given the gift of Salah!

Return to Makkah

On his way back to Makkah, on the Buraq, our beloved Nabi ﷺ passed a group of traders who were travelling to Makkah.

In the morning our beloved Nabi ﷺ told the people about his journey but they did not believe him and they mocked him.

They asked him to describe the Masjid. Allah Ta'ala gave our beloved Nabi ﷺ a vision of Al Aqsa so he could answer correctly.

Our beloved Nabi ﷺ further told them of the traders coming to Makkah and how far they were.
