Hajj takes place only in Dhul Hijjah

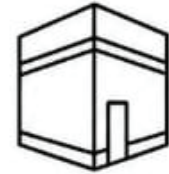


Millions of Muslims arrive from around the world.

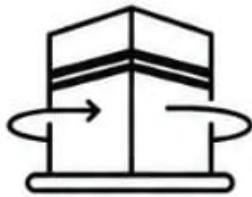
LABBAYK

Everyone must enter the state of Ihram which includes wearing two white sheets for men.

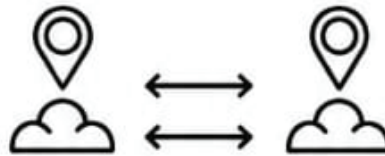


Everyone arrives in Makkah eager to see the Ka'bah and make Du'a.



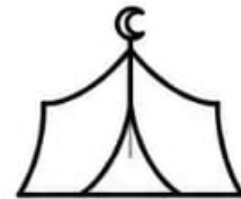
TAWAF

They perform Tawaf (going round the Ka'bah seven times)



SA'EE

They perform Sa'ee (walking between Mount Safa and Marwah seven times)



MINA

Everyone will go to Mina which is a vast area with large tents.



ARAFAT

A main part of Hajj is the worship in a place called Arafat.



MUZDALIFAH

One night is spent in Muzdalifah. Here, pebbles for Ramee (pelting) are collected.



RAMEE (PELTING)

Finally they will perform Ramee (pelting), Nahr (animal sacrifice) and Halaq/Qasr (shave/trim the hair). By doing this they will exit the Ihram.



RETURN HOME

After Hajj some will head back home.



MADINAH

Others will visit Madeenah al-Munawwarah.













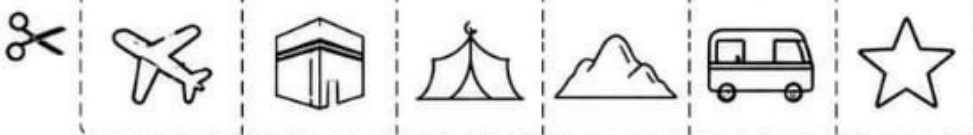

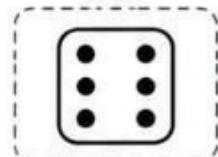
How to play:

<p>10</p> <p>Helped someone? Move forward 1.</p> 	<p>9</p> <p>Missed your bus to Mina! Go back 1 space.</p> 	<p>8</p> <p>SA'EE</p>  <p>Walk between Safa and Marwah (7 times).</p>	<p>7</p> <p>MAKKAH</p>  <p>Alhamdulillah you are in Makkah.</p>	<p>6</p> <p>Traffic on the way! Miss a turn.</p>

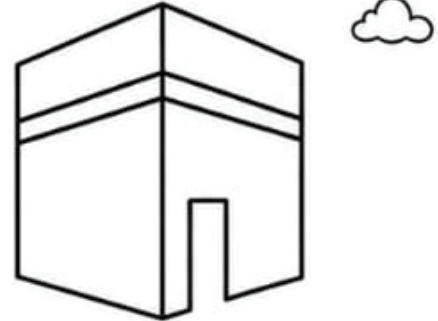


☆ THE FIFTH PILLAR OF ISLAM ☆

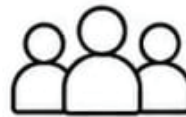

Our beloved Nabi ﷺ said:

"Whoever performs Hajj for Allah and avoids sins and bad speech will return like the day his mother gave birth to him."

(Bukhari & Muslim)

This means Allah Ta'ala forgives all of their sins.

Hajj takes place only in Dhul Hijjah.



Hajj is compulsory once in a lifetime for Muslims who are able.



The Ka'bah is the House of Allah Ta'ala.



During Hajj, men wear two simple white sheets called Ihram.



Hajj is a special invitation from Allah Ta'ala and only the fortunate servants of Allah Ta'ala are able to visit His blessed House.

TALBIYYAH

Pilgrims recite the Talbiyyah during Hajj:

لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَبَّيْكَ - لَبَّيْكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ لَبَّيْكَ - إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ وَالنَّعْمَةَ لَكَ وَالْمُلْكَ - لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ

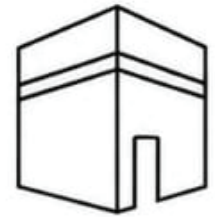
Labbayk Allahu Labbayk, Labbayk La Sharika Laka Labbayk, Innal-Hamda Wan-Ni'mata Laka Wal-Mulk, La Sharika Lak.

Here I am, O Allah, here I am. Here I am, You have no partner, here I am. Verily, all praise, grace, and sovereignty belong to You. You have no partner.




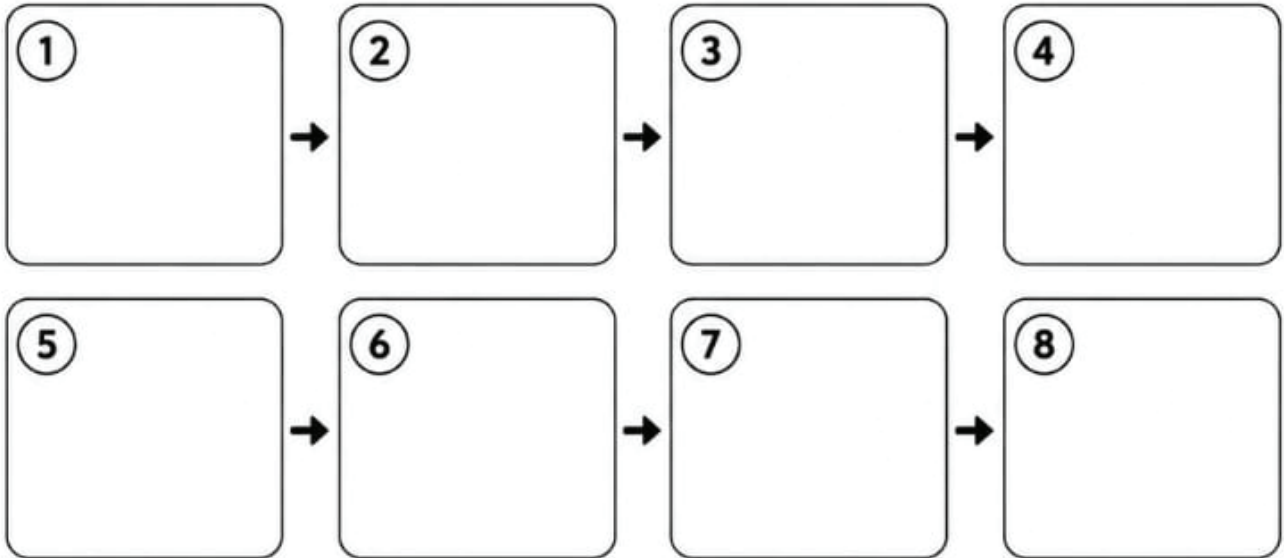



